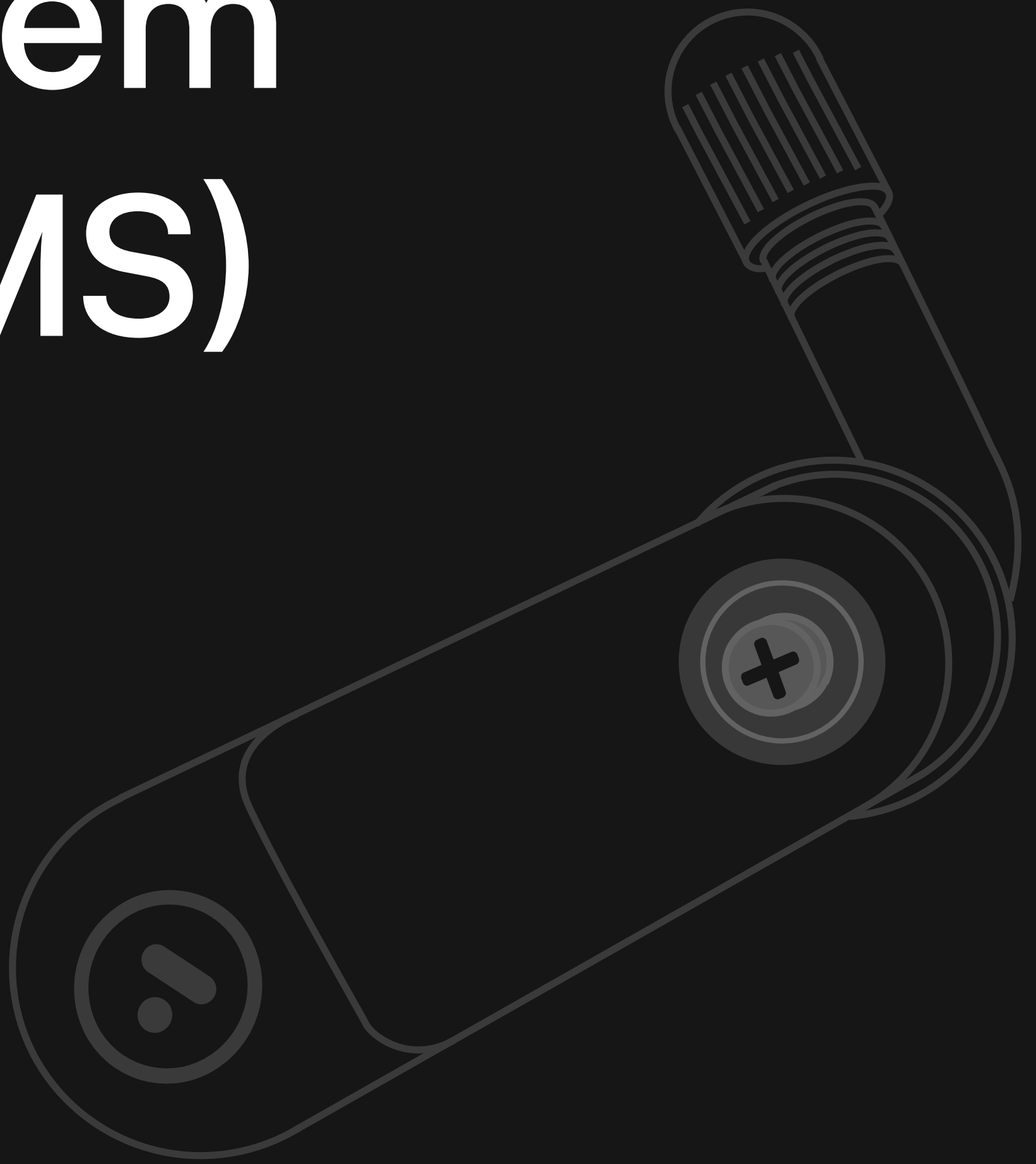

Tyre Pressure Monitoring System (TPMS)



A pair of sensors that help maintain ideal tyre pressure to deliver optimum performance.

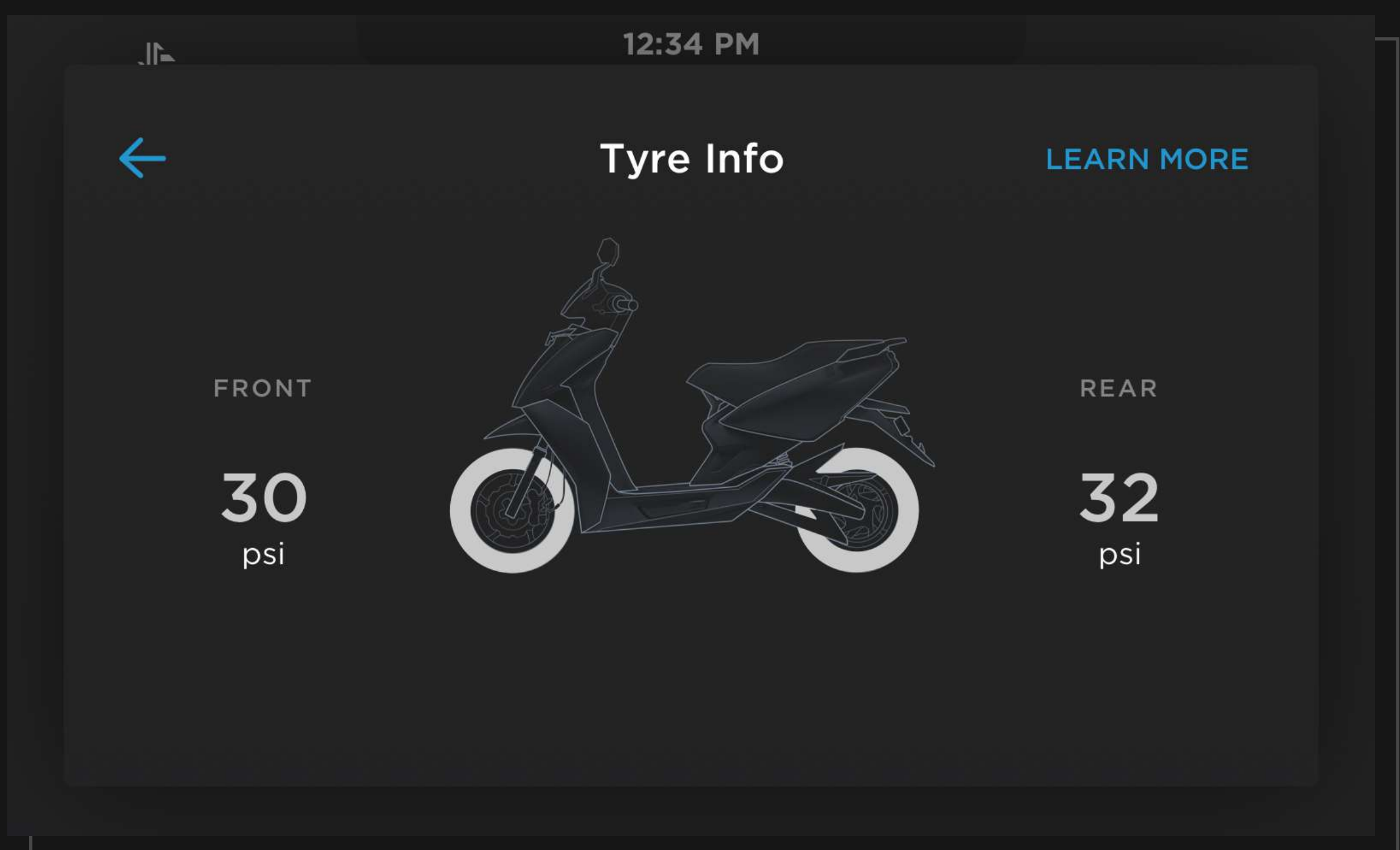



How does the TPMS work?

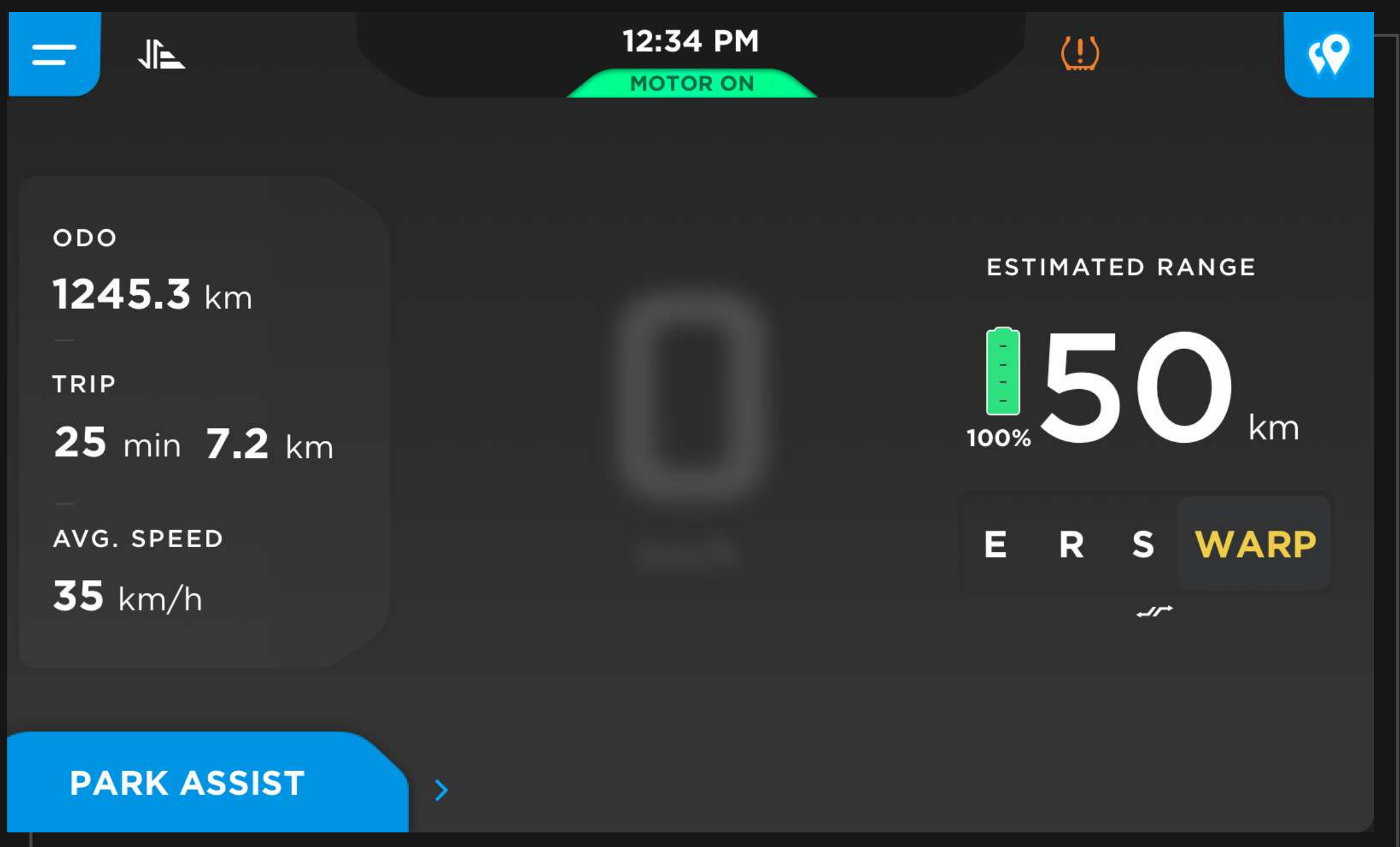
It connects with your scooter dashboard and mobile to alert you when the air pressure in one or both tyres is not in the ideal range, and nudges you to take precautionary measures.

Dashboard alerts:

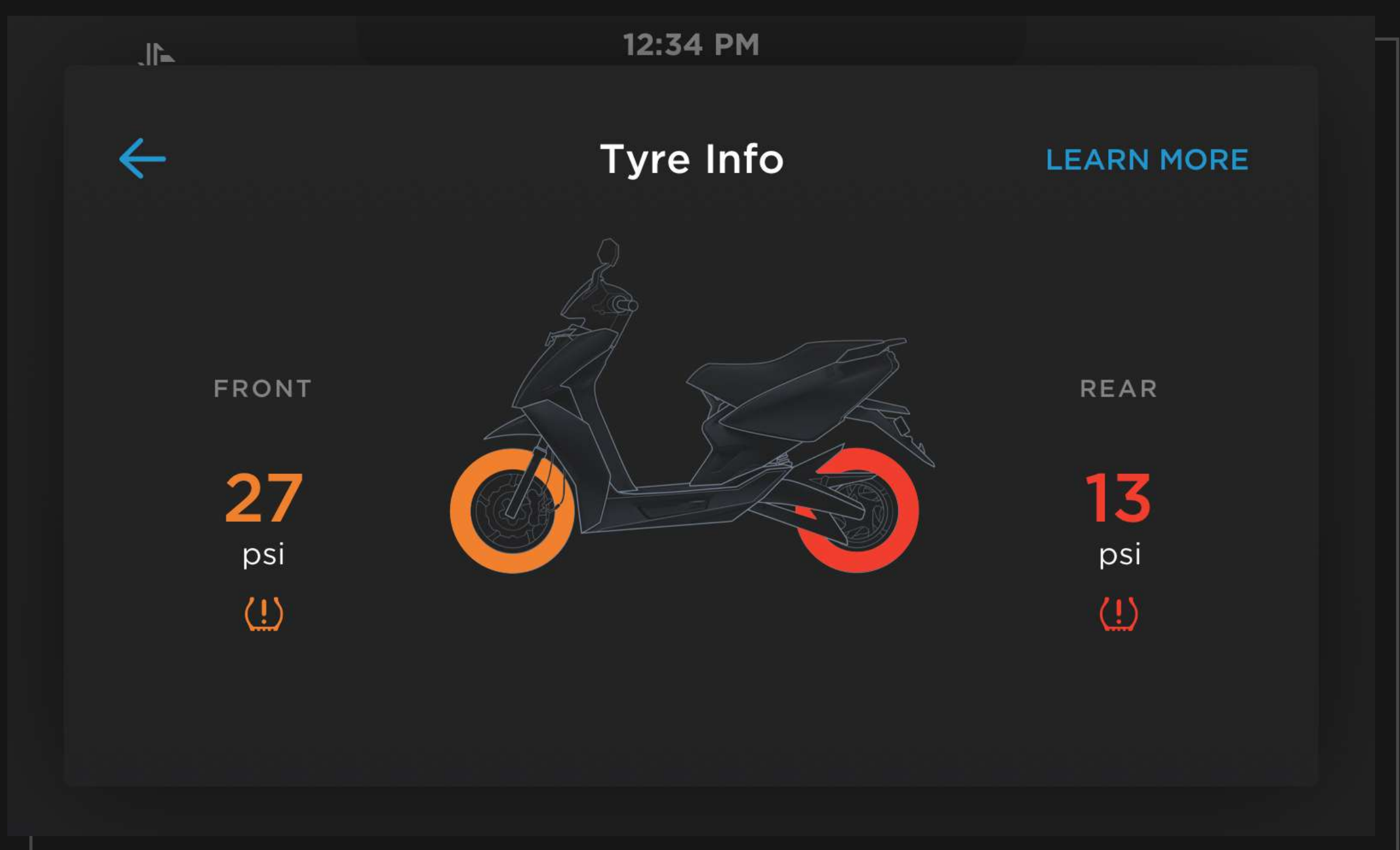
View real-time tyre pressure on the 'Tyre Info' screen in your dashboard. Tyre pressure values are displayed in PSI units.



A warning symbol  appears on the dashboard when the air pressure in one or both tyres is not in the optimum range.

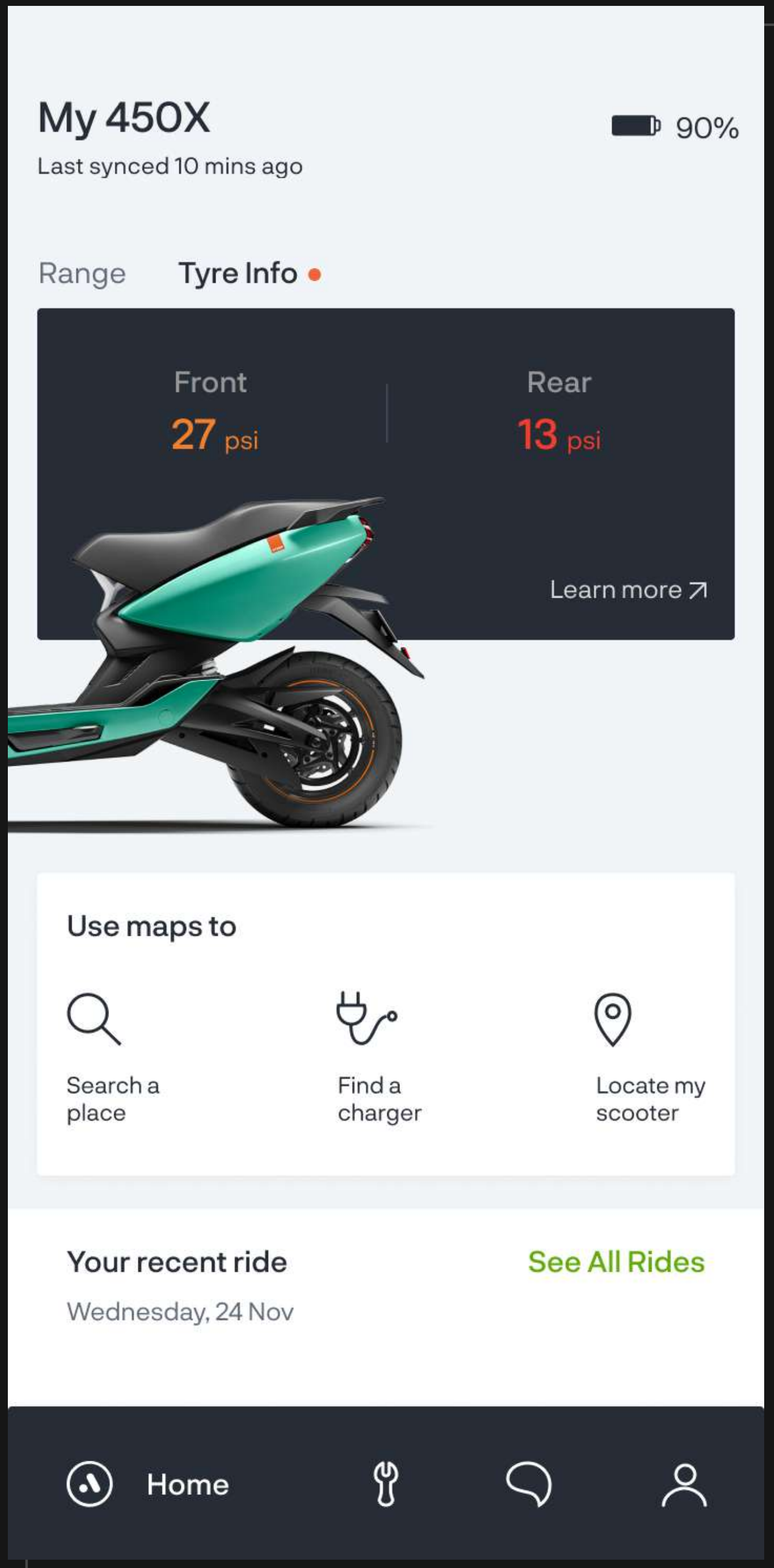


Click on  to view the status of the tyres.



Ather App alerts:

View real-time tyre pressure on your Ather App, within the 'Tyre Info' tab.



Warning lights

White/black light

Air pressure in both tyres is just right.

Amber light

Air pressure in one or both tyres is outside the optimum range. This can reduce the performance, and life of tyres.

Red light

Air pressure in one or both tyres is extremely low or high. Avoid riding the scooter until the air pressure levels are brought back to normal.

Note:

Maintain the ideal tyre pressure, to avoid loss of performance and other safety risks.

Weather, terrain, weight load, and other factors can cause slight variation in the tyre pressure values.

A failure notification on the dashboard and Ather App will alert you if a sensor fails or the battery runs out.

A non-replaceable battery is installed in these sensors.
